A patient who regained human rights in the course of ISTDP treatment.

- Working with a fragile character structure. This case presentation you show how to:
- Help the patient to face feelings they avoided through their self-neglect;
- Help the patient see and let go of defences of somatization, weepiness, and projection;
- Use the technique of bracing to build the capacity to bear feelings without using primitive defences;
- Help the patient process unconscious feelings so they do not need to ward them off through self-punishment.



Beata Zaloga, M.D. - psychiatrist, psychotherapist in 'Laboratorium Psychoedukacji' Training and Psychotherapy Institute, in Warsaw. She is the chair of the ISTDP Section in Polish Society for the Integration of Psychotherapy. She completed the training for ISTDP trainers organized by Jon Frederickson and ISTDP Institute in Washington. She has been practicing and teaching Intensive Short Term Dynamic Psychotherapy in Laboratorium Psychoedukacji for almost 10 years. Presently, she teaches at introductory courses and core trainings of ISTDP in Poland.
